2015 GSX-S750 Overview

The original Suzuki GSX-R750 was designed as a street-legal bike that was born on the circuit. Now the GSX-S750 gives that championship-winning heritage even more street-smart performance. Blending just the right mix of modern sportbike performance with futuristic streetbike style, this 750 is purpose-built for excitement.

Inspired by the architecture of the powerful 749cc four-cylinder fuelinjected GSX-R750K5 sportbike engine, Suzuki created a new powerplant that produces the perfect power curve for street riding. The camshaft profiles have been specifically developed for the GSX-S750 and matched with unique intake and exhaust tracts that boost low-end torque and mid-range power. This gives the GSX-S750 unmatched throttle response and intense acceleration. Suzuki dual-throttle valve fuel injection means the performance is crisp and consistent.

Handlebars replace the race bike's clip-ons, delivering a more upright streetbike style. A complete instrument cluster features adjustable brightness, plus an analog tachometer, a digital LCD speedometer, a fuel-consumption meter, gear position indicator, fuel gauge, odometer/trip meter and a clock.

2015 GSX-S750Z Additional Features

A special version of the exceptional GSX-S750 with a blue and white paint scheme that salutes Suzuki's racing heritage. Additional accents, such as bright-gold anodized legs on the inverted front forks, silver matte-finish handlebars, a drive chain with blue side plates and a red rear shock absorber spring add to the bike's performance look.

The potent 749cc 4-cylinder fuel-injected engine is tuned to deliver a dynamic wave of smooth torque and strong acceleration. Based upon GSX-R750K5 architecture, this engine builds power at lower RPM's faster than its competitors. Combined with state-ofthe art Suzuki Dual Throttle Valve (SDTV) fuel injection and a close-ratio 6-speed transmission the GSX-S750 is an ideal choice for any type of riding.



Suzuki Dual Throttle Valve (SDTV) equipped electronic fuel injection maintains optimum air velocity in the intake tracts for smooth low-to-mid rpm throttle response. This class-leading performance technology was developed through Suzuki's championship-winning racing teams, and affords the GSX-S750 with better performance, reliability and fuel efficiency.



A precise and smooth-shifting, close-ratio 6-speed transmission with cable operated multi-plate clutch provides the GSX-S750 seamless power delivery at any road speed. The transmission's vertically staggered shafts in the crankcase aid in keeping the engine compact, thus aiding handling as well.



Lightweight and compact radiator is used to maintain the proper engine temperature so the GSX-S750 operates properly and efficiently. An additional liquid oil cooler further increases cooling capacity while keeping weight and complexity low.



A generous 4.6 gallon fuel tank, along with the GSX-S750's efficient Suzuki fuel-injected engine, provides abundant riding range for extended commuting, touring or sport riding. Sculpted knee panels on the tank flow into the stylish radiator shrouds.



Carefully sculpted aggressive front bodywork and side panels make a brash statement about the bike's ability. Further cues to its performance potential are in the vented front fender, molded mirrors, chiseled fuel tank, low 32.1 inch seat height, and textured tank side panels.



The distinctively shaped headlight nacelle contains a bright halogen bulb centered in an organically shaped multi reflector that incorporates high and low beams as well as dual position lights. The angular tail section houses an integrated LED combination tail light that arches high above the hugger sub-fender.



Spring preloaded-adjustable 41mm inverted KYB front forks and link-type rear suspension with spring preload-adjustable single shock connected to a steel beam swingarm provides a precise, yet comfortable ride during varied riding conditions.





A reasonable riding position is created by a carefully crafted relationship between the tubular handlebars and the footpegs. These elements complement the seat location to maximize the rider's comfort and control. All of this is part of a chassis that combines the advantages of a twin-spar sportbike frame and a compact tubular street frame to deliver a dynamic ride.

The GSX-S750's angular styling treatment features sharp, interconnecting lines for an unmatched rakish look that includes three-spoke, cast aluminum-alloy wheels. The 17 x 3.50 inch front wheel and a 17 x 5.50 inch rear wheel hold premium tires that balance grip with mileage.
